

TRUE or FALSE?

1. Blockbuster® supports the school by donating one videotape rental-free to the school every Friday. The video is shown in a classroom to reward students with perfect attendance that week. This is fair use.
2. A social studies teacher taped a news special report showing Richard Nixon leaving the White House after he resigned. She made it at home on her personal VCR and used her own tape. She uses the entire news program every year in her classroom. This is fair use.
3. A teacher rents *Gone With the Wind* to show the burning of Atlanta scene to her class while studying the Civil War. This is fair use.
4. Copyrighted material used in multimedia projects may remain in the student's portfolio forever.
5. *Seinfeld* has an episode on personal hygiene that a health teacher tapes and uses the following week in class. The local TV station denies permission when asked and states this is a violation of copyright law. They are correct.
6. A student brings in a CD copy of the national anthem that he copied from a CD lent to him by a friend. Another student digitizes this into a PowerPoint show. This is fair use.
7. A high school video class produces a student video yearbook that they sell at community events to raise money for equipment for the school. They use well-known popular music clips. The money all goes to the school and the songs are fully listed in the credits. This is covered under fair use.
8. Students create a 30 second commercial for an after school activity, to be shown on the closed circuit TV at their school. The students created the commercial for a class project. There is music from a current rock album played during the commercial. This is fair use.
9. A librarian tapes "60 Minutes" every week in case teachers need it. This is fair use.
10. A principal finds an outstanding article in a professional journal. She copies it and distributes it to colleagues, including her faculty members. This is fair use.
11. A second grade teacher records her voice on a cassette tape reading the book *The Little Engine That Could*. Her students use the tape every day in the listening center. This is fair use.
12. A middle school teacher uses the same article on how the body systems work every year, and has for five years. He hasn't found another one that is as thorough. Every year he makes a copy for his class and keeps one in his files. This is fair use.
13. The librarian makes a back up copy of all software CDs and motion picture DVDs purchases for the library. This is fair use.
